

Killymoon Rangers 0 – 2 PSNI FC

This was a game which PSNI needed to get points. Brown was able to strengthen his squad from last week with Keith Wilson, Graham Arthur, Willie Fry all back from injury and Johnny Stephenson also available.

At a rain swept Killymoon, PSNI were first to settle and took the lead within 3 minutes. Some good work down the right between Gibson, Stephenson and Adamczyk saw the left back gather the ball just inside the Killymoon box and after a quick swivel left he turned the Killymoon defence before hitting a thunderous strike from 16 yards, the ball nestling in the top corner of the net with the home keeper well beaten.

PSNI continued to dominate with some good link up work between Hamill, Hadden and Adamczyk. On the left flank Mackle and Holden were a constant thorn in the Killymoon defence. Hamill went close on a couple of occasions and PSNI should have consolidated their lead. With 15 minutes to go to the interval Killymoon came more into the game and created a few good chances. With 10 minutes left Keith Wilson pulled off a magnificent save diving low to his right to push a goal bound shot for a corner. On the stroke of half time good work down the PSNI right saw Adamczyk measure an inch perfect pass for the in running Hadden who coolly lobbed the home keeper from 14 yards.

The second saw was less of a spectacle with both teams having a few half chances. In the end PSNI ran out convincing winners. This performance/result will have pleased Jimmy Brown. A few PSNI players looked tired around the 75 minute mark. With other players returning from injury it is good to see competition for places. PSNI now need to build on this result.
