

Double Strike from Adamczyk

The importance of Lucas Adamczyk to the P.S.N.I. as a striker was clearly demonstrated in the opening twenty minutes of this League game played in perfect conditions at Newforge.

The first came after 15 minutes when he slotted home a left wing cross from Rory Hamill and the second when he picked up a loose ball in midfield, ran ten yards and beat Damien Nugent in the visitors goals with a brilliant drive from twenty yards.
